



<sup>1</sup> Beginning in 2023, ISU changed its peer institutions. For salary comparisons, ISU now compares against other Very High Research (VHR) institutions as defined by Carnegie. Data collected by Oklahoma State University. The percentages evaluate ISU average salaries against the average salary for the same rank at participating VHR universities. For example, an average salary of \$75,000 for ISU compared to VHR average salary of \$78,000 would yield a comparison value of 96% (the percentage of 75000/78000). This would indicate that ISU faculty earn 96% of what is earned by comparable faculty at VHR institutions.
